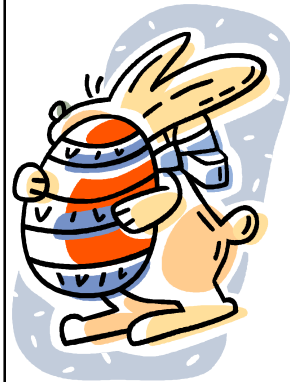
Donations Needed for Class Egg Hunts

Lunch Box Ideas

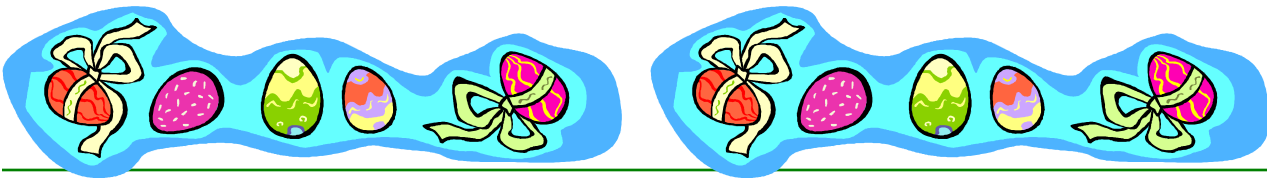
