

EMERGENCY CARE FOR YOUR CHILD As per our Parent Handbook

If your child should become seriously injured you will be notified immediately. There is a release form you sign as part of the admission application. This gives us the authority to get medical attention for your child in the event of an emergency. The source of emergency care would be the CLOSEST HOSPITAL. By signing the identification and emergency information form you grant permission for the staff to take what ever steps may be necessary to obtain emergency medical and dental care if warranted. The steps may include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Attempt to contact parent or guardian.
- 2. Attempt to contact parent or guardian through any people listed on the form.
- 3. Attempt to contact the child's physician or dentist.

The child's family will be responsible for any expenses incurred. If the emergency is such that a child's life is determined to be in danger, 911 will be contacted first before attempting to contact a parent or guardian.
